PUBLIC NOTICE

Consultations on the revision of the agricultural zone (LPTAA article 59) concerning residential uses.

Public Notice is hereby given by the undersigned, that the planning department of the MRC is presently making a study which will revise residential uses in the agricultural zone in accordance with article 59 of an act respecting the preservation of agricultural land and agricultural activities (LPTAA), and that the MRC will be holding 3 public consultation meetings on its territory in order to collect the comments of the interested persons or organizations.

In effect, article 59 of the LPTAA allows an MRC to submit a collective request to the Commission de protection du territoire agricole (CPTAQ) in order to determine in what cases and what conditions new residential uses could be implemented in the agricultural zone. In accordance with this law, the study wishes to identify in the decreed zone, « des îlots déstructurés » such as a grouping of existing non agricultural uses, and « sectors » where the agricultural activities are marginal. It is in these areas that residential uses could be authorized under particular conditions.

All interested persons in this collective request in the agricultural zone are invited to attend one of the 3 public consultation meetings, depending on the municipality involvement :
